Minutes from the Baronial Meeting that took place on February 20th, 2005

Which occurred at the Pine Ridge Apartments clubhouse in Durham, NC.

The February Baronial meeting was called to order at approximately 4:15 pm.

Baronessa Maddelena thanked everyone who had made Ymir such a wonderful event and stressed the importance of Ymir to the Barony. She thanked the Scriptorium and many others for their work at Ymir.

Officer's Report's

Chirurgion-

Has completed an apprentice event and is looking to complete more. Said anyone needing him to assist at an event should contact him.

Chronicler-

Dunstan is now the official chronicler. Reminded everyone that the deadline for the windlore was today and that anything that needed to go into the windlore should be turned in today. Asked to approve 36.00 in funds to send hard copies of the windlore to three members of the barony with no access to the electronic windlore. Motion passed, seconded, no objections.

The **Knight Marshall** offered apologies for not having advertised the Baronial practice earlier. Mentioned that he is looking for a replacement.

The **Baronial Herald** spoke of several heraldic submissions he is helping with.

The **Minister of Arts and Sciences** talked about the upcoming KASF, mentioned the plethora of competitions and displays, and asked for \$300.00 to be allocated towards having a change box for troll at the event. Motion passed, seconded, no objections. James talked about some of the competitions going on at KASF.

The **Chancellor Minor** said that kids activities at Ymir went well and cost nothing.

The **Exchequer** said that Ymir went well, although final numbers are not in. 584 people checked in at troll. There is about 14,000 dollars in the Baronial Bank and about 4,000.00 is allocated. Alaric asked about what it costs for the Barony to run in a year, and the exchequer said approximately 3-5 thousand dollars.

Manus Macdhai stepped forward as the new **Archery Marshall**.

The **Seneschal** mentioned that the next Baronial Meeting will be at 4:00 on March 20th, but that the meeting place is yet to be determined. Once it is determined, it will be posted on the Keep.

He asked how many people were planning to go to Pensic and about 15-20 people raised hands. He mentioned looking for volunteers to help coordinate a Baronial encampment.

He mentioned that the paperwork for The Stronghold of Eagle's Landing had been submitted and also noted that another group in the Eastern Part of the Barony was possibly going to

be started and would be asking for Baronial Zipcodes.

Canton Reports

Attilium reported that they once again raided Raven's Cove. They will be doing a simple lunch at KASF as a fund raiser. The 22nd of April there will be a demo at the Fayetteville Library from 6:00 pm to 9:00pm. The Canton A&S calender has been updated.

Buckston reported that attendance at meetings is a little down (usual seasonal fluctuations). Tuesday is still the practice and meetings, Thursday is still A&S and recorder practice. June 17th-19th Buckston will be hosting the event 'Midsummer Twilight Tourney'.

Elvegast talked about the Renn Faire demo. Rosalind described it as an important membership drive demo and encouraged people to help out (last weekend in March, 1st one in April). There is the possibility that in the Fall Elvegast will host a small event called 'Bardic, Bardic, Bardic.' There are also plans to host a very 'spiff' French themed event in Spring of 2006.

K-Berg also mentioned that they were planning a Spring event in 2006 that would be a 'Mardi Gras' type themed event and they would work with Elvegast to insure no conflict.

Nimenfeld is discussing Cattle Raids for next year. Elspeth said that the Tea at Ymir was very well received.

OLD BUSINESS

YMIR-Alaric gave thanks to multiple Ymir Staff members, including Phillipa for running troll, Ursula for the spiff website, Wystan for constant service in any way needed, and Gaston and

Christopher and all the MoL's for running fields of 100 + fighters and finishing on time.

Eogan then stood up and mentioned the many people from the Barony who received awards at Ymir. There were a whole lot.

Clare then discussed the fact that there was a Bardic held there which was closed to the general populous because it included in part a squiring ceremony and expressed displeasure at the use of a public building for private gatherings at an event.

NEW BUSINESS

Ceridwen and Kimber stood up to talk about the upcoming event Tournament of Chivalry (April 16th). She went over the budget in some detail and asked for \$3,005 to be allotted for the event. She also mentioned that at Curia at KASF it would be proposed that ToC every year after expenses would put the first \$350.00 of net profit towards the Pensic Children's Fete. Motion to approve \$3,005.00 made. Seconded. No objections.

Phillipa mentioned Glassworkers guild and scriptorium meetings in March. Both are advertised in this month's windlore.

Baronessa Maddelena mentioned that Sacred Stone's event 'Phoenix Eye' is in June and Windmasters needs to have a strong showing in both attendance and in Arts and Science displays.

She also mentioned that the Baronial benches need to be sanded and painted. A discussion followed, led by Gaston, about needing a 'Love-the-Fence' fund to make repairs. Steafan volunteered to look into that project.

The Baronessa added that they are still taking any bids for Baronial Champions.

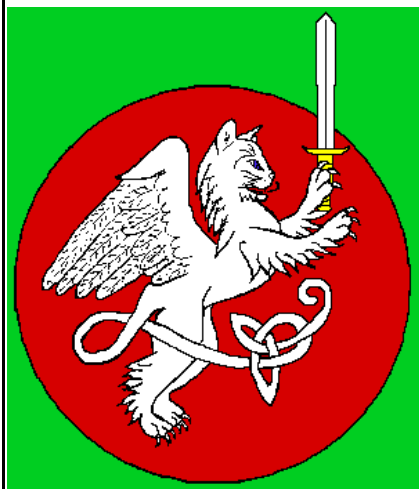

Baron's Weapon of the Month Tourney (a message from Their Excellencies)

We wish to sponsor a series of tournaments to be held at the canton fighter practices between February and August with a final tournament to determine the overall champion at the September baronial fighter practice. Each tournament will be fought with a different weapon style with the last one having rotating styles for each round.

The purpose of these tournaments is to encourage our heavy fighters to learn and become proficient in all the weapons of the lists. As these tournaments will be held during regular fighter practices, authorization in the weapon for that month is not required but is highly recommended. Please use this as an opportunity to learn to fight with and authorize in all of these forms.

The format for each tournament will be at the whim of the Baron and based on how many fighters wish to participate. All fighters are encouraged to fight in as many of the tournaments as they are able with members of the Order of Chivalry, who have won a tournament with that weapon at some point in the past, being asked to act as marshals and coaches for that month.

The dates and places have been tentatively selected based on being near the end of the month, on the Baron's ability to be present and an attempt to spread them around the Barony. The proposed schedule is:
