## Minutes for the Baronial Meeting in November

Held at Pine Ridge Apartments Club-  
house on November 19th*

Chow called the meeting to order at 4:10pm.

**I. Baronage comments:** His Excellency was pleased that Windmasters' Hill came to support the event in Marinus the day before. Windmasters' Hill composed a significant proportion of the participants there. His and Her Excellency both commented on the fabulous Pas d'armes event the previous weekend. Everyone worked hard to be spiffed up, and it was a wonderful change from the typical SCA event.

### II. Officer Reports:

**Chatelaine:** Eibhlin asked that canton chatelaines please contact her. She does not know who are the current chatelaines because many canton websites are not currently up-to-date. She also would like to be contacted whenever demos are planned. Attilium is having a demo for scouts on Nov. 28<sup>th</sup>. She also talked about possibly having a recruiting demo sometime in March next year.

**Chirurgion:** Andreas reported that there have been some injuries and that fighters should check their hand protection to be sure it is adequate.

**Chronicler:** Dunstan had hoped to come to the meeting but had to work with 180 girl scouts today. He needs a deputy to eventually take over as Chronicler in the future. He may need a deputy at work as well!

**Herald:** No report.

**Knight Marshal:** Alaric reported that they had a useful practice this afternoon. About 13 heavy and 6-8 rapier fighters came out. Cuan would like to see a January practice with spears. They are looking for an indoor site to fight. It cannot have carpet or wood floors, and they'd prefer that it was not concrete floors either. There was discussion about using Dorton Arena. Gaston will check to see if it is available and what the cost might be to rent the space. An allocation of baronial funds could be made to cover the costs of renting the site. There also is a desire to keep fighter practice and baronial meeting at the same site so officers who fight don't have to quit so much earlier to attend the meeting.

**Rapier Marshal:** Rosalind reported for Chris that enough rapiers were present, which gave an opportunity to do melee work. They would like to see more rapiers to have better melee practices for upcoming wars.

**Archery Marshal:** Manus said that he wants to find time to have an equipment and arrow-making workshop. It was suggested that it could be held in conjunction with the January fighter practice if an indoor site is found.

**Arts & Sciences:** Therasia is stepping down this month and Jehannette is stepping up as the baronial MOAS. She has some ideas that she will share with us at upcoming meetings. Therasia also reported that Siobhan contacted her today about being a deputy MOAS.

**MOL:** Elspeth said that Zita had nothing to report. If people need an MOL please contact Zita. Maddalena indicated that she's listed as the MOL for Ymir but she has other plans for that day!

**Web minister:** Malcolm said that people had asked him about posting pictures of the baronial candidates because some people are having trouble putting faces to names. He is in the process of putting information about the candidates on the baronial website. Corwin would like members of the barony to add their names to the baronial phone list. Some people do not want personal information listed online even though efforts are being made to keep spam harvesting from occurring. There was a request to at least list one's name.

**Quartermaster:** Beatrice said that Gracie had suggestions for kitchen/cooking items we still need for cooking and serving feast. Maddalena requested that serving pieces be purchased to serve high table. There also were requests to purchase serv-

ing pieces for all tables. People do not always bring or want to re-use personal serving pieces when at feast. Please e-mail Beatrice with suggestions. Beatrice was told to check with Idonea because she originally had started a list. Piero indicated that there was \$484 already allocated for kitchen items.

**Warlord:** No report.

**CHOM:** Margaret now has a deputy who will be replacing her at Ymir – Marianna, who has been doing wonderful kids activities for local events.

**Exchequer:** Piero reported that he will be stepping down in April when his warrant expires. Regarding finances, he reported that we have a total of \$12,556.62, of which \$8,597.59 is allocated, which leaves \$4,359.03 unallocated. Piero reported that there are a number of allocations that have not been touched in months. He listed all the allocated categories. Nikulai suggested that at the next meeting Piero come with a list the funds that haven't been touched in 9 months so that we can consider unallocating the funds.

**Seneschal:** (1) Chow got a call about hosting the War of the Wings in May of next year at the same site. He told them we would not be doing it for a number of reasons, including not currently knowing who Their Excellencies will be at that time. He suggested that they declare war on someone else and we can decide which side we will support. (2) Regarding Baronial polling, Chow indicated that zip code requests are going out tomorrow. He requested \$400 to conduct the Baronial polling, to cover all the costs (supplies, printing, postage, etc.). The motion was seconded and passed. The plan is to get the polling mailed out before December 1<sup>st</sup> and people will have three weeks to get the polling back to Their Majesties. (3) Chow now has two deputies: Philippa and Bjorn.

### III. Canton Reports:

**Attilium:** Oisín announced that Attilium would be having their Viking Christmas party on December 2<sup>nd</sup> – the same day as Unevent. It will start at 3 and last until ?, and is on the Fort Bragg base. Check the Attilium website for more information. He also announced that the second weekend in December they are having an archery shoot.

**Buckston:** Philippa said Buckston is still having European dance on 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesdays, Hafla on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesdays, and traditional A&S classes on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesdays of the month. Rapier practice continues this winter. If the temperature is 40 or below they'll do footwork drills inside. If the temperature is above 40 there will be rapier practice outside. Buckston is discussing hosting another Midsummer's event in May or June. Tessa is to be the autocrat. Tessa has also agreed to be Buckston's deputy seneschal. Buckston had a demo at Durham Academy. There were some issues about teachers not being present for all the groups of children.

**Elvegast:** Rosalind reported that the Pas was a success and quite well received. They are continuing to meet on NCSU campus while classes are in session. When school is not in session they will be meeting at Two Guys Restaurant. Philippa mentioned that some of the students are interested in lampworking and there will be an opportunity to make beads at the craft center sometime in January.

**K-berg:** Girard announced that their class list was recently posted online. All speakers don't have topic announced but come and hear what they have to say. They always go out to dinner afterwards. There will be no fighter practice on Thursday (Thanksgiving). They also will not be having canton meetings on December 25<sup>th</sup> and January 1<sup>st</sup>. Girard will be stepping down in January and his deputy Beatrice will become the new seneschal.

**Nimenefeld:** Elspeth said they would participate in the Holly Springs parade on December 9<sup>th</sup> and invited everyone to join them. They are not having fighter practice in the winter.

#### IV. Old Business:

(1) Since money is already allocated for the fighting eric (\$30), Gaston suggested that we should finish getting it into shape. There is a need for corner posts and other repairs. He offered to cost it out and report at the next meeting. Rather than do that a motion was made to allocate an additional \$250 to the eric fund to get it ready for Ymir. The motion was seconded and passed.

(2) Alaric is now the autocrat for Ymir. The announcement is on the Kingdom website and it will go to the Acorn by the end of this month. There are many jobs that need to be filled. Several people volunteered to help, but he still needs more. If someone is considering being autocrat for Ymir in the future he or she should

consider being deputy autocrat this year to learn about running the event.

(3) Girard and Guenievre were thanked for providing the meeting space for this month. After some discussion it was decided that we should have a baronial meeting in December. Oisín indicated that the library room they use for A&S is large and available. He will make the arrangements for the room and we will plan on meeting from 3-5 to be sure we are out by 6pm when the library closes.

**V. New business:** Maddalena announced that she and Geoffrey will again be hosting the "Come as formal as you like" New Year's Eve party. You must wear clothes, but it can range from shorts to tux.

#### VI. Announcements:

(1) Today is the birthday of Piero, Dunstan, and Catarina. Piero invited people to get together for dinner after the meeting.

(2) Unevent is in Jacksonville, NC on December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Officers are required to go or to send a representative.

The meeting was adjourned around 5:15.

### Unto the Populace of Windmasters' Hill does Tangwystl ferch Morgana send greetings,

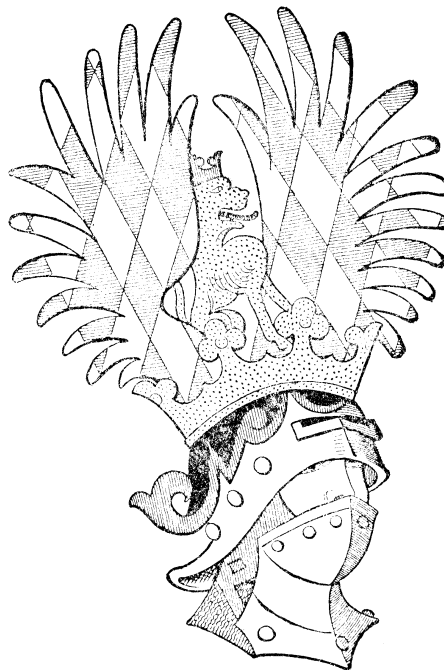
As the days turn colder and the days shorter, I wish you warmth and light. May your candles burn bright and your wood pile be large.
