July 7th-9th is our Baronial Champions event. Competitions will be held to choose champions to represent Windmasters' Hill in heavy and rapier martial arts, archery, brewing, static and performance A&S. Let it be known to all who read this that I do declare Lady Trephina to be the Goddess of Quality Note-taking and thank her for her many minutes.



Minutes for the **Baronial Meeting in April**

Minutes for the April Meeting were taken by the Goddess of Quality Note Taking, Lady Trephina.

Deputy Seneschal Chow called the meeting to order at 4:15pm on the 16th of April at Carolina Pines Park.

Baronage:

Maddalena had several announcements:

- 1) The Baronial workday has been moved to April 29th to work on Barony projects at Geoffrey and Maddalena's house. The date was moved so people can attend the BoD meeting in Richmond on April 22nd.
- 2) Sapphire Joust People had been asking about a Baronial encampment. Beatrice has volunteered to be camp steward and is the point person for the encampment. Registration for the encampment ends in two weeks. Geoffrey will not be able to attend the event but Maddalena is planning to be there.
- 3) Baronial champions People have asked if there was a focus for this event. There are two foci - Germany 1330-1400 & Italy 1470-1540 to reflect the interests of our Barun and Baronessa. The current Baronial champions cannot repeat their posts, but are encouraged to participate and to help choose the new champions. The prospective champions must participate in three events, which include one non-fighting competition for the fighters and one fighting competition for the arti-Their Excellencies have included one additional champion category - brewing champion.
- 4) War of the Wings Geoffrey recounted the Sacred Stone investiture story in which they were first given a gift basket of pet toys to calm the feisty Kittyhawk, and then were presented the remains of a Kittyhawk caught on their lands. Our Barun challenged Baron Marc to a series of challenges: 5 passes with heavy weapons (each a different form), 3 passes with rapier (each a different form), one pass of arrows, and one pass on horseback. There are war points to be won in martial activities as well as arts and sciences. The Barun is making known he will provide hospitality to those who fight on the side of Windmasters' Hill, and alcohol will be

involved. Everyone would like to make this an annual event and have fun.

Exchequer:

Piero reported the current totals for Baronial funds: \$13,382.44 total, \$4,696.62 allocated, and \$8,685.82 unallocated. There was an emergency meeting of the finance committee to approve funds for the local storage unit because the rent had Typically we reserve the amount to rent the shed so we can allocate it as part of operating funds. Discussion ensued. The rent has been going up every two to three years. A motion made and seconded to allocate \$1500 for NC storage unit to cover the next 13 months. The vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Piero mentioned the need to do an inventory in the next quarter. He will coordinate with Beatrice to get this done.

The camp is making significant renovations in the dining hall and camping areas and could be a possible location for future events. A&S is held on Sundays at the library.

Buckston

Trephina mentioned two Buckston events. The Heralds and Scribes event is May 13, and is free. Lunch and deserts will be sold to support the site's building fund. Class listings should be online now. John Neal will be bringing scribal supplies at the event for sale. The Midsummer's event is June 17, with Philippa as autocrat and Irmgart as head cook. Edward de Clare will be teaching a western martial arts class at the event. There will be Artisan's Row again this year.

Elvegast:

Rosalind said the Ren Faire demo finished last weekend. Calli will be sorting out contact info and send them to the seneschals. They gathered fewer names than last time but probably have persons that are more interested in SCA than the previous year. Calli and Solvarr said thanks to cool stuff or doing demonstrations. Next year we may be moving to a new location because the fighting area is gravel is not fun to fight on, so they are checking out other spots. A new area for A&S could be very close to the new entry (gate 7) and they hope for more grassy areas for fighting. Calli was not sure if we will get a donation from the Ren Faire people because attendance was poor this year, but it will take a couple of weeks for them to go over the books. Calli posted a link to photos on the Keep.

K-berg:

Girard reported they just finished picking new classes for next quarter. The list should be up on their web site as well. Fighter practice on Thursdays at 7, and they are staying later.

Elspeth announced fighter practice is now at South Park. There were 6-8 fighters there last week. Plans for Cattle Raids are getting in gear.

Nikulai asked about the last edition of baronial phonebook and its status. Elspeth formerly was in charge, but now it is being done by Steafan. It will be available by next Baronial meeting, but it will take a couple of iterations to get it right. It will be in a number of formats.

Pennsic: Gerard & Guenievre are in charge and are trying to keep up with the forms and paperwork. Forms for camping with the Barony were distributed. The formula for land allocation is the same as last year, but people are asked to please read the directions since some persons were confused last year. There is one typo in the form - do not mail it to Maddalena but to Guenievre. Checks are to be made out to the Barony and are going through the Baronial accounts. Registration dates with the Coopers have changed. May 15th for registration by mail, and June 15th for online registration. Baronial forms must be sent to Gerard and Guenievre to register with the Barony. They are going to check with the Quartermaster on stuff in the shed, and may come back with requests for tools (e.g., shovels, posthole digger, very long measuring tape,...) to be purchased and left in the shed in PA. Gerard and Guenievre will take two vehicles to Pennsic, but may need help taking stuff up there. Also, making benches to leave up there would be a good idea. Gaston said he can make benches if others will provide the funds. There will probably be a pre-Pennsic trip to take stuff up to the shed in PA.

New business:

Nikulai mentioned that Crusades the first weekend in October would make a good melee practice.

Adriana said that if anyone wants to volunteer to work at Pennsic it can be done online.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 5:05.

Two Warriors in the Woods

The warriors seemed to be beginning to tire, yet it was still unclear as to the outcome of the battle. However, the Phoenix and Kittyhawk agreed that it would be a shame for either combatant to be slain.

As the two mortals were locked in combat, suddenly the Kittyhawk swooped down between them and knocked the blades from their hands. The warriors fell to the ground in stunned amazement as the Kittyhawk flared its great wings and stood before them in all its magnificence. White wings and fur shone as bright as the noon sun and power seemed to radiate outwards.

Before the two warriors could recover themselves, the Phoenix flew down and began to sing the sweetest song ever heard by mortal ears.
