

Exchequer's Balance

Greetings!

First, the baronial balances: We have \$4334.12 allocated and \$8814.58 in the general fund for a total balance of \$13148.70. These amounts are current as of 20 July 2006.

Second, the event balances from Baronial Champions: We had allocated \$2800. The total expenses were \$2451.22, so our budgeting was good. Net income was \$2086, so we had a net loss of \$365.22. Given our account balances, we can handle a slight loss with no discomfort. Thank you to Therasia and her staff for a great event, and cheers for our new baronial champions!

Third, the baronial inventory: If you have in your possession any items which belong to the barony you need to send an inventory of those items to Beatrice, our Quartermaster. Do not just put the items back into the baronial shed, as we have already inventoried the shed. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter.

Minutes for the Baronial Meeting in July

Chow brought the meeting to order at 3:50 at the Optimist Farms gazebo. We decided to start the meeting a bit early since the fighting had stopped.

Baronage: Their Excellencies would like the seneschals to discuss the curia items at their canton meetings. They thanked Therasia for the great Baronial Champions event held this past weekend. They also thanked everyone who worked on the event. Baronial A&S is cancelled this week since Their Excellencies will be out of town. The Baronessa will probably be out of town for most of the month so call the Barun if you are interested in coming over to do A&S work on Wednesdays this month. Maddalena said it is not too early to think about submitting bids for next year's Baronial Champions. It doesn't have to be in July again. We shouldn't go three years before choosing the next champions.

Seneschal: Steafan announced that he was informed that the fee for Camp Kanata next year is \$1800 rather than \$2000. We already have been 'penciled in' for the second week in February, but he would like to send in a deposit to reserve the time. A motion was made and seconded to write a check for \$250 for the deposit for Ymir. The measure passed. Steafan also noted that there are increasing complaints about petty theft at events society-wide. He cautioned everyone to take more notice in the venders area, and to keep an eye on your thing. He also emphasized that all officers need deputies. Seneschals should go to their cantons and urge people to take deputy roles as Baronial officers.

Officer Reports:

Baronial Warlord: Alix reported we had a good practice today. Next month is August so the war meeting is Pennsic. He would like to have a picnic at future Baronial practices, starting in September. Steafan said the next meeting is Sept. 17th. People indicated a preference for Lake Crabtree. Some complained about walking out too far to observe the practices. Calli reminded everyone that group events could not be next to the parking lot. It

was suggested that practice be held closer in next time so that there is some shade for people observing. Fighter practice will be 12-4, with the Baronial meeting at 4. Calli was asked to inquire about reserving shelter space for the meeting in case of rain.

Knight Marshal: Alaric reported that he is still the Baronial knight marshal according to kingdom records, so he's back. Wystan's warrant for Buckston is on the way to Kingdom. Artus' paperwork also will be sent up to kingdom this week so both Buckston and Kberg will have knight marshals. Alaric will stay as Baronial marshal for the time being.

Exchequer: Piero will have event-related information and the current balances in his report for this Windlore, which will be submitted later this month after all the checks have been written. He still needs receipts to be turned in to write reimbursement checks for the Baronial Champions event.

Chatalaine: As of this weekend Eibhlin will be Chatalaine so Livia can devote more time to pages academy work. Eibhlin reported that the Fayetteville demo last week went well. It was well supported by the local group, but they had hoped more people from the Barony could have participated. She urged seneschals and chatalaines to talk to their local groups on how we'd like to deal with demos and requests to do demos. There are many new members in Attilium, but they primarily are in the SCA, and just new to Fayetteville. In most places the newcomers are new to the She suggested we institute an 'adopt a newcomer' program to give more individual attention and be better mentors for newcomers.

Chirurgeon: Galen has passing the role onto Andreas. Andreas reported that no one died or had much heat or alcohol-related problems at Baronial Champions. Everyone did a great job policing themselves. He urged those going to Pennsic to work to start adapting to the heat. It also was mentioned that if you have an unusual condition or take medications (e.g., for diabetes), please provide this information at Chirurgeon's Point at Pennsic.

Chronicler: No report – he's out of town this week.

Herald: No report – she's out of town this week too!

Rapier Marshal: Chris wants to encourage more participation in the Baronial

practices. There were only two rapiers at practice today. Talk to rapier fighters in the cantons about coming to Baronial practice. Ivy mentioned that we also need more combat archers to come to practice as well. Galen is the new Baronial rapier champion. He will be coming up with a list of things we need for rapier gear. We are moving to schlager use (except for those only authorized in epee). They will be going to Triplett to get information for schlager loaner gear.

Archery Marshal: Manus had a good shoot yesterday. Unfortunately there were more non-Windmasters' than us and they were better! We will need more and better archers to get the war point at War of the Wings. We also need more target archery marshals. A problem is that there are not many places to practice archery. There may be an indoor range in Raleigh. We need to find a farm or somewhere else. The Tuesday archery practices at Steafan' is for any type of archery. Trying to have a practice during the week is difficult. The weekend would be easier and that's what we need to do to have more effective practices.

Arts & Sciences: Therasia said Sveva, our new Baronial Champion in static arts, will be posting to the Keep about A&S activities at the War of the Wings. Their Excellencies of Windmasters' Hill and Sacred Stone discussed how the A&S points would be awarded. They decided that every entry will count towards the war points. The better it is the more points we get. So quantity and quality are both important. We will be working to help people's documentation. The A&S at War of the Wings must be items never entered in competition. There will be an A&S "display" at Cattle Raids so that individuals can get commentary and feedback on their works and documentation. A requirement for War of the Wings is that you must be present to enter the competitions. There are many categories to enter. We should try to cover all categories to get the most war points!

MOL: Zita reported that there were 5 authorizations yesterday and 2 renewals. She needs a deputy.

Web minister: No report

Quartermaster: Beatrice and Piero will do baronial inventory next Sunday, July 16, starting at 10am. She would like to talk to the cooks to see what is needed for feasts in the future. A list will be brought to the populace to decide on what should be purchased. There was a question regarding serving pieces for high table as there were not pieces for the feast yester-

day. The kitchen equipment needs to be better organized so we can see what we have and what we need. Maddalena and Geoffrey will donate a mandolin slicer. We also need a first aid kit for the kitchen. Andreas said he would put one together. It appears that the tablecloths were missing. There is supposed to be a signout system to get items from the shed. Additionally, items should be returned immediately and kept in the shed. We should all help Beatrice with this because it is a difficult job for one person. Elspeth said that there are not enough SCA signs to post this event. Some were borrowed from Nimenfeld, but there are not enough Baronial direction signs. While they do the inventory Beatrice will look for the reflective material that was used to make the Baronial signs so more signs can be made. Because not all signs get returned after events "sign repair and attrition" might have to be added to the budget. We will discuss that after the inventory. People who have Baronial items stored at the shed at Pennsic or at their home should tell Beatrice and Piero so they can be recorded in the inventory.

CHOM: No report.

Regional Seneschal: Idonea would like to briefly meet with the seneschals and deputies after the meeting.

Canton Reports:

Attillium:

Oisin reported fighter practices are at Lake Rim Park on Sundays at 1pm. Come join them.

Buckston:

Helwynn reported Midsummers Twilight Tourney went well and everyone had lots of fun. We are still meeting on Tuesdays with rapier practice before the meeting. There is heavy practice when marshals show up.

Elvegast:

Calli reported that they are still meeting Thursday nights.

K-berg:

Girard announced that they are picking classes tomorrow. Send Girard information if you are interested. Fighter practices is on Thursdays--rapier at 5, heavy at 7.

Nimenefeld:

Elspeth said fighter practice is on Wednesdays at 7. Several knights are there. On Thursday nights there is A&S at Zita's starting at 6:30. Since Pennsic is coming the focus is on quick tunic construction. Canton meetings are at Milano's on Tuesdays. Come at 7 to eat or 7:30 for the meeting. Eogan said they

still have positions to be filled for Cattle Raids. The webpage is out. Cattle raids might be a royal progress. Once again they are making a focus on newcomers. Last year Elvegast did an effective job helping newcomers—they had a potluck off board for newcomers and a tent for them to hang out or whatever. There will be a Gold Key tent with garb on hangers. They still need tents for teens and kids activities.

Old Business:

Girard: Pennsic stuff—bring your new bench to use and leave there. They should hear soon which block has been assigned. Things are going well, there are just a few small details to work out. A meeting will be held at the Kberg clubhouse in July. Hopefully they will have a mockup for land layout, and they can discuss chores and other details.

Adriana: A reminder that Elvegast is hosting the Pas d'armes de l'Arbre d'Or Nov. 10-12 at the Farm Ventures site. Check the website—more information has been posted including hotel information. There are still positions available so talk to Adriana to help.

New business:

There was no new business. With no further business the meeting adjourned at 4:55.

From the North and East: Make your best way to Raleigh, NC, at Raleigh get on Rte 440 (which is the beltline that goes around Raleigh). Go to the South side of town to Exit 298A which is Rte 401 South to Fayetteville and Garner. Go south on 401, stay on the right because 1.4 miles down the road, the road forks, stay on the right and go another 5.3 miles to Rte 1010 and turn right, go .5 miles and turn left onto Lake Wheeler Rd, go 1.2 miles and turn right onto Optimist Farm Rd, go .9 miles turn right into the site, there will be SCA signs and your mileage may vary

From the South: from Rte 95 go north on Rte 55 after you make it through Fuquay-Varina you will come to a light on the edge of town. Directly across is a Sheets gas station and a Exxon. Turn right, start measuring there, 2.8 miles north you will come to a five way intersection at a light. Turn left onto Hilltop Needmore Rd, go .4 miles to the next light and turn right onto Lake Wheeler Rd, go 2.3 miles and turn left onto Optimist Farm Rd, go .9 miles turn right into the site, there will be SCA signs and your mileage may vary
