Greetings from the Baronial Archery Marshal!

Things have been a bit slow of late on the archery front within the barony but spring and warmer weather is coming!

ARROW MAKING WORKSHOP I recently announced on the baronial email list and at the baronial meeting that I am holding a workshop on making arrows for target shooting February 24 (Saturday) from 1pm to 5pm. The location of the workshop is my house in Cary (See directions below). I will cover the basics of constructing target arrows, what

tools are needed, and where to order the materials. These will be bare-shaft arrows (not stained, sealed, or adorned) though we can talk about how one would do such things. Anyone is weilcome to come but if you want to take a dozen home with you, the materials will cost \$38 (or \$19 for a half-dozen). I have sufficient materials to make around 7 dozen arrows; if you want to take a set home with you, please RSVP with the draw-weight of your bow and your color choice of cock-feather (blue, black, red, or yellow; the other two feathers will be white). If the weather is good and we finish early enough, we might even be able to test-fire a few at a target in my backyard.

Directions:

Take your best route to Exit 287 of I-40 (N. Harrison Ave). Turn toward Cary after exiting (if you end up in Umstead State Park, you went the wrong way). Go about 2.5 miles and turn RIGHT onto NW Maynard Rd. Go about 2.2 miles and turn RIGHT onto High House Rd. Go about 0.3 miles and turn LEFT on to Castalia Dr. Go about 0.3 miles and the house is on the right, where the powerline cross the road. The house is blue-grey two-story with a big side yard (under the powerline).

If you can't make it to this workshop, I am planning to hold another next month (probably on the 24th again).

NOTE: If you have allergies, I have two cats.

INDOOR TARGET RANGE IN RALEIGH: Carolina Outdoor Sportsman Inc. recently opened a store in N. Raleigh and it has an indoor target range. The store is located at 9650 Strickland Rd. suite 149, just west of Six Forks rd. (Same shopping center as Lowes Foods). The range is open the same hours as the store (9am-8pm M-Sa noon-6pm Su). The range is 20 yards and can accomdate 7-8 archers on the line at the same time. The cost to use the range is \$12/hour or \$8 for a half hour. You can buy a annual membership for \$200 which entitles you to unlimitted shooting. You do need to sign a waiver form and there is slightly different waiver for minors. Other restrictions are target points only (that's all we use anyway) and no crossbows. Website is http://www.carolinaoutdoorsportsman.com/ and the phone number is 919-676-6799.

OUTDOOR RANGE IN RTP: I have also been looking into the Durham County Wildlife Club. (http://www.dcwc.net) Located just south of Hwy 54 between Davis Dr and Hwy 55, it is primarily a firearms practice range but they also have archery facilities. I learned that they also have an indoor range and it is open to the public on Tue day nights 7-9pm at a cost of \$5 per adult guest. I am also looking into requirements for access to the rest of the archery facilities.

Minutes for the Baronial Meeting in January

Minutes of the Barony of Windmasters' Hill January 2007 Baronial Meeting, held at Mann Hall, NCSU Campus.

Chow brought the meeting to order at 4:10.

Baronage comments:

Geoffrey announced that they have successors – Gaston and Rosalind. Their Excellencies appreciated all those who put their names in for the polling. Geoffrey announced they would have a Friday court for Ymir, a tradition started by Falcone. The investiture will probably occur during morning court on Saturday. He thanked everyone who came for fighter practice today. The fighters need to do more drills and work together as a unit.

Gaston thanked everyone for their support. He announced that some changes would be coming up in the future. One thing Gaston wants is to meet with all seneschals and marshals and card-carrying fighters on Sunday after Ymir on site, maybe 11am in the hall. He wants to talk about the timing and arrangement of practices, etc. If any fighter has a thought about this please talk to Gaston. [Later Gaston decided to postpone the meeting so it wouldn't interfere with Ymir cleanup.]

Maddalena announced that she is continuing to host A&S nights on Wednesday nights. Please call to let them when you are planning to attend.

Officer Reports:

Chatalaine: Eibhlin announced the NCSU Demo 2/6/07 10:30-4 by the D.H. Hill library, and a Cliffdale Library Demo in Attillium: 3/10/07 from 12-4. She would prefer that we only do 1 or 2 demos per quarter for this year so people don't get burned out. Local chatalaines and seneschals should contact Eibhlin when they are planning to do a demo so she can coordinate help. It was mentioned that the Emerson Waldorf School in Chapel Hill wants a demo. No decision was made on whether to agree. The original email was going to be reposted for people to con-

sider whether to agree to do the demo. Elvegast is trying to decide if they want to do the Renaissance Faire demo. This vear's Faire now covers 3 weekends coronation, Easter (which will have a Friday midnight madness), and another weekend. Elvegast is going to decide which weekend to do and will contact Eibhlin on their decision to participate. Other thing Eibhlin mentioned had to do with the announcement of newcomer events or information. Ursula has done a fabulous job on the Ymir website for newcomers. A number of different people are concerned about recruitment as well as people leaving. How do we keep people involved in the SCA? How do we get new members? What about getting new fighters? Maybe there should be a discussion about that.

Chirurgeon: Andreas announced new kingdom Chirugeon: Morwenna from Bordervale Keep. He would love to have a deputy. He hopes to have no problems at Ymir. If there are hazardous areas or other issues noticed at Ymir, please let someone know.

Chronicler: Dunstan was not here.

Herald: Tangwystle needs someone to be a new herald. James of Middle Aston is a candidate for the position if no one else steps forward. Beatrice still has the baronial herald's box of stuff. It was suggested she keep it for now.

Knight Marshal: Alaric noted that there were a core of dedicated fighters coming to the baronial practices but the turnout is pretty slim. More fighters are showing up for war and they are getting destroyed by their opponents because not enough fighters are practicing for the wars.

Rapier Marshal: Wystric said 9 people showed out for rapier practice.

Archery Marshal: Manus was not here.

Arts & Sciences: Jehanette is trying to set up a Baronial A&S activity every month – maybe a different weekend than practice so fighters can go and participate too. She would like to set something up for next month's meeting. She is thinking of a roundtable discussion of documentation – what works, etc. People should bring documentation to see what works or needs to be critiqued. Would meet sometime in February, maybe the 4th weekend or the Saturday of the 3rd weekend. If people

have other ideas for classes let her know. String thing is started again. There were questions about holding classes before fighter practice (11am or the evening after the meeting). A&S in spring and summer during fighter practice has worked in the past. Kingdom A&S is coming up so maybe we should do the class about documentation. University is next weekend.

MOL: Zita said nothing going on. She's looking for a deputy. Helwynn's name was mentioned as a possible deputy.

Web minister: Malcolm was not here. There have been problems with the Keep because the spam filter was catching legitimate messages. Chow thinks that the issue may be fixed by now as his messages are now getting through.

Quartermaster: Beatrice has nothing at the moment. She did mention that she would still like to add more kitchen items.

Warlord: Cuan is not here. Chow mentioned that he would like practices to start on time and then the later melee practices could start sooner in the afternoon.

MOM: Margaret reported that she didn't have much to say. Mariana is stepping up.

Exchequer: Piero announced that the Domesday report is in and the numbers are good. As of the beginning of the meeting, the total in our bank account: \$11,551.15 of which \$7,497.60 is allocated, and \$4,053.55 unallocated. Checks need to be written for Ymir, and if you have receipts see him after the meeting. He's looking for a deputy. Maybe one lined up.

General discussion: Philippa noted that a non-fighter can be a youth marshal. There will be youth marshal classes at University. Nikulai said there is a lot of grumbling about autocrating. There will be three courses at University: an autocrating roundtable as well as Autocrat 101 & 102. Seneschals should also go to those classes as well because seneschals are official deputies of their group's event.

Seneschal: Chow notes this is Windmasters' Hill's 30th birthday for Ymir. Come look good and celebrate. Thanks to Erica for getting a room for today's meeting. Cheers for Erica! Robert Maxwell hasn't

been playing much, but keep him in mind. He and his wife are about to take a month off to go to Vietnam to adopt a child. Eldred would know how to contact him. Robert hopes to come to Ymir – if so, give him a hug if you see him. Thanks to everyone who stood for the polling. We had a really great group of candidates. Gaston would like to meet with Chow and the other officers and would like to codify the expectations of officers and champions. This originally was Sveva's idea but it was never followed through. It is probably a good idea to start fresh on this. Everyone should start trying to define his/her job descriptions. It will let everyone know what is expected. Gaston said they should probably also should talk to the orders later. Chow asked about whether we can get the deposit back for last week's Baronial meeting cancellation due to weather. Ros is still working on it. Everyone thanked Ros and Gaston for setting it up. We could possibly use the gymnasium at \$50/hour, but the fighters need to wear tennis shoes.

Canton Reports:

Attillium: Oisin said they really appreciated all the Baronial candidates coming down to their meetings. They felt like they were really a part of the Barony. Meeting schedule is still the same: 1st Thursdays is A&S, and 3rd Thursdays is the business meeting at the library. Fighter practices are at Lake Rim Park, which is a very cool place. They are getting cranked up to support Ymir. Someone mentioned that the Attillium website needs to be updated on locations.

Buckston: Philippa announced that the Buckston Website is being updated. Meetings are going well - large attendance. Cuan has been showing up for fighter practices and there also are rapier practices. If there is inclement weather the rapiers might go inside for footwork drills. English country dance 1st & 3rd Tuesdays, Hafla on 4th, and A&S on the 2nd Tuesdays. Midsummers Twilight Tourney Event is scheduled for June 8-10, with the theme of Don Quixote. Horses will be involved as part of the event. A Spanish midday feast is planned. The plan is to have A&S workshops on Spanish garb, cool decorations, etc. Jehanette asked about having a Spanish costume workshop for the Barony at some point. Philippa mentioned that for fighting, there might be a Provost's rapier challenge. As with previous Midsummers events, there

also will be an Artisan's Row – see Francesca about participating.

Elvegast: Rosalind said Elvegast is going well. Ormarr is to be next seneschal and he has a deputy. They are discussing Renn Faire and will report back to the Barony what they decide. There is a zipcode issue of two that used to belong to Elvegast before Wake County added more zip codes. Adriana as seneschal had gotten permission to have them reallocated to Elvegast from the Barony, but there was a snafu at the Kingdom level. Rosalind emailed all the canton seneschals, Chow, and Their Excellencies about this and she's heard no objection. A pie piece out of Raleigh and Optimist Farm is at issue.

K-berg: Beatrice is now the seneschal, but not yet on the seneschal e-list. They are still meeting Monday nights, but the room has changed to the big room across the hall. Classes are still going on. Monday is Viking stuff. Their website is updated with the most recent classes. New listings will be decided in February for Spring classes. If you are interested in teaching something let them know. The fighter practice spot is being converted to a pool. They are looking at a possible new site for practices in Carrboro but their marshal has to check it out. Wystric is still doing fencing at 5:30. Chow said the park is not going to start work on the pool for a while so maybe practices could continue there for now.

Nimenefeld: Elspeth said Nimenefeld would hold a fundraiser at Ymir – hot & cold drinks and a bake sale. Currently their finances can cover Cattle Raids and their storage shed but they need more cushion. Please bring donate or bring things to sell at Ymir. There are no fighter practices due to the lack of lighting and the weather.

Old Business:

Alaric: Ymir is coming fast — it's in two weeks. He will be onsite at noon on Friday. If anyone can help please come out. He's looking for a few more people with trucks to meet at the Baronial storage around 9:30am on Friday. Anyone with a truck please come and help. Most of the major jobs are filled, but they may need helpers. Please talk to Malcolm for kitchen clean-up. Eibhlen needs servers and people to move tables. Girard will need help with site clean-up. Many hands make light work. Eibhlin and Margaret Pennington will be doing hall decorations.

Alaric will respond to people who have said they have banners. Tracy said she could run around to pick up banners. There are also banners in the storage shed. Chris said he would help with parking. Ymir's site is continuing to evolve – they are putting a swimming pool where the list field used to be. Where we used to park is to be the fighting field. Parking will be across the street where the horse field was. and this will be closer to the field. Gaston announced there will be no driving on the fighting field because it is too sandy. Gear will have to be hauled on and off from across the street. Tennis courts can be available for pickups or the old fighter field if they haven't broken grown. A new pavilion near fighting field is available to serve lunch. Troll will be in the staff office or the fish hall. Chow will bring wood. Douglas is in charge of fireplaces in the main hall. Saturday night's bardic will be in the main hall. Alaric is not sure when we have to be out of the fish hall. Baronial Court will be Friday at 8pm. Feast has been extended to 160, which covers most of the waitlist. The schedule is being reviewed by TRM and will be posted soon. A&S competitions at Ymir all things Viking. Kathryn Rous has sponsored Where have all the Vikings Gone. Mistress Susanna is teaching a class on double-faced tablet weaving. There might possibly be a bardic competition. Let Jeannete know if you can judge in any of the competitions.

There was a motion to add \$320 to the Ymir budget to allocate for the added feast spaces. The motion was seconded and passed. Alaric mentioned that this is likely to be a large Ymir and many people attending, so be nice and friendly.

New business:

Eogan said the new Triton Herald gave him a week off then she asked for another Kingdom Heralds and Scribes event, and for him to autocrat "In the Trenches" – an outdoor university. There would be outdoor fighting and the mock fighting to train MOLs, MITs, chirurgeons in training, etc. Eogan wanted to see if there is any interest in the Barony supporting this event because it is too large for Nimenefeld to host. Early summer is the target date. We have to supply the place and food (luncheon -- possibly a fundraiser). Every kingdom office would be represented to show how their job is done. It

needs a site for all the work that is done outside. Optimist Farm might work. Eogan was asked to work it out.

Pennsic needs a new camp steward. Gaston talked about working with Efenwalt to get more spaces for the common area.

Nikulai noted that turnout has been fantastic for the past two moves for SCA members. We rock!

The meeting was adjourned at 5:40. Submitted by Lady Trephina.

Minutes for the Baronial Meeting in February

Minutes of the Barony of Windmasters' Hill February 2007 Baronial Meeting, held at Subway off of Lake Wheeler Road on February 18th, 2007. Approximately 25 people in attendance.

Baronage comments:

Her New Excellency Rosalind thanked everyone for all of their help with making Ymir so successful. TE still want to have a meeting with all of the Seneschals, Marshalls and fighters of the Barony soon to organize the Baronial fighting force.

Officer Reports:

Chatalaine: Eibhlin was not in attendance.

Chirurgeon: Andreas announced that there were no injuries reported at Ymir, other than a lot of complaints about how cold it was.

Chronicler: Dunstan reminded everyone of te windlore deadline (which is, was, and always will be the 20th of the month). He apologized for not making it to more meetings but work has been difficult. He then pleaded in an almost whiny way for people to submit stuff to him for the Windlore.

Herald: James of Middle Aston is now the Baronial Herald and he has (GASP) a deputy who will be taking over the job when she feels ready (her name is Rhianalyth, or something to that effect). All heralds need to send in their warrants. There are 5 new awards and one new order in the Barony (with descriptions to be included in this Windlore on page 11). In order to finish approval of these awards paperwork must be sent in and paid for. The total was 100 dollars. Motion to grant it for that purpose was made, seconded and passed.

Knight Marshal: The fencing marshal is moving and we need a new one. The Baronial practice earlier that day was very cold and poorly attended.

MOL: Zita did not MOL ymir but heard that it went well.

Web minister: Malcolm said that the Keep is now suffering from several problems. Comcast accounts are rejecting letters to the keep. The Baron brought up the idea of looking into an on-line forum (lik a bulletin board and discussion group). Lots of discussion followed. Malcolm was asked to look into it

Quartermaster: Beatrice said we have lost pots at Ymir (4-5 of them!) We need to engrave WH in all pots instead of writing it, and we need to go back to Kanata and try to reclaim our pots.

Alaric is still doing Ymir final numbers but says it went very well and made money. He wants to finish up the budget write-up to hand it on to the autocrat of next Ymir (whoever that might be). He said that lots of people worked very hard at Ymir and he challenged everyone at the meeting to send in award recommendations immediately for people who went above and byond the call of duty.

Elvegast: Seneschal was not there, but the Raleigh ren faire demo was brought up by Jehanette, who said they are only doing one of the three weekends this year and encouraged people to beat the bushes and get people to come and fight/demo with them.

Nimenefeld: After Ymir two newcomers showed up to the Nimenfeld meeting.

Old Business:

The Baroness brought up that she and Gaston fronted money to reserve a site for the Baronial Meeting and they needed to be reimbursed. She asked for 60 dollars. Motion was made, seconded and passed to grant those funds.

Maddelena brought up the subject of new coronets. She plans on shopping around at Gulf Wars for people to make them.

New business: Next year Ymir will likely not be able to be held at Camp Kanata, as their prices are going up and they may not be willing to open the bathrooms that early. New sites must be investigated for that event.

A Lotion Recipe from Late Period England

By Lady Rebecca the Contrary

There are many recipes available for ointments or salves. However I've never seen an actual recipe for lotion. This recipe from Markham Gervase is specifically to make the "hands very smooth". It is neither a cure nor anything to help a problem. It is simply a recipe to make the hands very smooth. This recipe is described as an "oil" however when it's complete it feels more like the modern lotions and cream.

Basic Recipe

To make an oyle which shall make the skinne of the hands very smooth, take Almonds and beate them to oyle, then take whole cloves and put them both together into a glasse, and set it in the sunne five or sixe days, then strayne it, and with the same annoynt your hands everie night when you goe to bed and otherwise as you have convenient leasure.(1)

Translation:

To make an oil which shall make the skin of the hands very smooth, take almonds and beat them to a powder and create a paste, then take whole cloves and put them both together in a glass and set it in the sun five or six days, then strain it, and with the same anoint your hands every night when you go to bed and otherwise as you have convenient leisure.

Notes:

I didn't have several days of sun so for this display I used commercial almond paste and cloves over low heat. To get the strongest scent possible, I simmered whole cloves in the water first, then cut up the almond paste and added it to the water. On low heat the almond paste melted very quickly and almost boiled over.

I continued to simmer for almost an hour and let as much of the excess water out as I could. I then poured it into a jar.

The recipe that I made actually felt a little grainy and powdery. I suspect that had I added a little more oil I would have had a better feel to the lotion and it might have felt more like a modern cream.
