Minutes for the Baronial Meeting in November

Meeting of the Barony of Windmasters' Hill November 26th, 2007

Held at the Regular Kappelenberg meeting at Chapel of the Cross, Chapel Hill, North Carolina

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Seneschal Chow. 33 people were in attendance at the beginning of the meeting. Approximately 15 more showed up throughout the meeting.

Chow started off by apologizing for moving the meeting but stated that serious issues faced the Barony and more time had been needed to understand those issues before a meeting could take place. Currently the Barony has several issues related to financial policies and practices which put the Barony in real danger of being suspended. Currently it is likely that the Barony is going to be placed on Financial probation and at Unevent (December 1st) given a list of things they need to do to fix the problems. If these problems are not fixed in a very timely manner it is likely that eh Barony will be suspended. In any case it is fairly certain that the Barony will be placed on financial suspension. Chow encouraged people to talk and ask questions but to act with courtesy and restraint. Fits or outbursts of anger were not appropriate and not constructive. He stated that Maddelena has offered to head up a financial committee to look into current policy and to help re-establish it. He also stated that one of the purposes of the meeting was to discuss how the Barony will solve financial problems such as paying bills and running events if they are on probation.

The Baron stressed that these problems boil down to accounting errors, not malfeasance. He stated a concern that the seneschals, exchequers, marshalls and other officers of the Barony are getting burnt out and that needs to change.

Chow agreed and added that the red tape and beaurocracy involved in being an officer is keeping some people from enjoying 'the neat game' we are a part of.

Makai was asked to stand up. She was there as the North Carolina Regional Exchequer for the Kingdom of Atlantia. She re stated that there is currently no reason to believe that there has been any intentional wrong-doing in the Barony. Every time there is a change in the office of Baronial exchequer there is supposed to be a review of the Baronial books. This has not been happening in the recent past, but it is now. She has reviewed our books and is working on a review of the books from the last three years. This finished document will be a public record and will be available to anyone who wants to see it. The review of the Accounts of Windmasters' Hill includes many shortcomings. Some of them are as follows;

- -Exchequer reports have been late
- -Reports have been unsigned
- -Event reports have not always been turned in; receipts are missing.
- -personal and private funds have been commingled. No money is missing, but the way monies have been handled is not good. -unreimbursable receipts have been paid out
- -membership and warrant of the exchequer are not up to date
- -no warranted exchequer since April in the barony
- -currently not a single baronial officer is approved to sign off on expense approval -there is missing documentation
- -some money advances have failed to be reconciled within the required 60 days -financial committee minutes have not
- -financial committee minutes have not been published in the windlore -money has been put in unused dedicated
- funds for too long without being freed up-financial stuff in general has not been published
- -no follow up paperwork on donations to the barony by outside agencies
- -there was a late notice on payment to the Pennsylvania storage shed.

Makai explained that a Barony under suspension could do nothing. A Barony can only be suspended by the Kingdom Seneschal. A barony under Financial probation could still do things that had nothing to do with money, but any financial transaction had to have direct approval by the kingdom exchequer. The Kingdom exchequer has the authority to put a barony into financial probation.

Makai stated that a proposed action plan will be offered up at Unevent (December 1st) listing all the things the Barony will be expected to fix. Makai's opinion (and her recommendation as regional exchequer) is that the Barony should not be running

events until and unless they have worked through these many issues.

Cantons will continue to function as normal

At this point food was ready and people were hungry, so a 20 minute break was called on for people to grab food. Food was generously provided by Kappelenberg via Guinevre and Beatrice (who were helped by several others)

When the meeting reconvened Makai noted as her closing statements that while the Barony had issues it was not the only group that was having financial issues lately. One group has been dissolved and another suspended. She believed that Windmasters was willing and ready to work through the issues and believed that they could.

It was observed by members of the populace at this point that many thanks were due to Makai, who had spent a lot of personal time trying to help identify (and thus help us fix) our financial issues and also to Benefse who had spent many hours trying to get the books back on track.

Valdemar asked to speak and proposed that the cantons gather together and make plans to pool their resources and hold Ymir, with one canton spearheading and the others providing resources.

Makai stated that she could see no problem with this.

Baron Gaston reminded folks that Ymir is not the only event coming up, and that the 'Got Vice' event in June would also likely be one we would need to call in canton help to make possible.

Maddelena, who will be heading up the financial policy discussion group, asked that the current provisional financial policy be posted on the Baronial website and that people read it and send comments to her.

A long and detailed discussion ensued then about when to meet for the 'after Unevent' discussion, for the Canton/ymir discussion, and the next full Baronial meeting. Many relevant points were brought up and the need for a speedy response to the plan we will be presented at Unevent was stressed. After much discussion it was decided that a tactical group of the baronage, seneschals and exchequers will meet after Unevent (on the same day – December 1st) to eat dinner and discuss a plan towards fixing our financial issues and at the same time the canton seneschals could discuss Ymir.

It was also decided that the next Baronial meeting will be at the Nimenfeld meeting place (Milano's pizza in Fuquay-Varina-directions to follow) on December 11th. The entire populace is invited and urged to attend.

It was then stated that we are now just going with the assumption that a canton is going to have to spearhead Ymir with the help of the other cantons. All canton seneschals were urged to go to their meetings (and call an emergency one if you have to) to discuss what each canton can do.

There was some discussion about profit sharing and how money from Ymir would be divided. Some people stressed that the majority, if not all, of Ymir profits should be donated back to the Barony. Others disagreed. This discussion was tabled for later.

Girard brought up the point that IF we are suspended it also means we can't have money incoming. This might make donations impossible (and will affect how Ymir monies are allocated).

Dunstan mentioned that the windlore had been held up to wait for the meeting to take place but that it would be printed and sent out promptly- any submission to the windlore had to be in by noon tomorrow (the 27th of November) or else it would not be in the windlore.

Chow thanked everyone for coming. It was announced that if officers had stuff to report they should send it in to the Windlore.

The meeting was dismissed at 9:25 pm.

While the meeting minutes end here (respectfully submitted by Dunstan LeHeryngmongere), there were several last minute reports by officers sent into me to

be added to the minutes, as there was no time to give reports at the meeting. Here they are:

Chirurgeon;

No one died. No new news. I will be attending Unevent. More Chirurgeons and Waterbearers are needed. Please contact me if interested to learn more. That is all. Lord Andreas de Caunteton

Chatelaine;

Local Chatelaines and Castellans are reminded to please forward news of demos and newcomers' activities to the Baronial Chatelaine for promotion and inclusion in Kingdom reports.

Lady Eibhlin will be stepping down as Chatelaine for Attilium in December 2007. The group is deciding upon a replacement at this time.

The Canton of Attilium will be holding a demo at the East Regional Branch of the Cumberland County Library System on Saturday, December 8, 2007 from 0900-1400. Local fighter practice has been deferred for this event and all authorized fighters are encouraged to attend and support the demo. Artisans and friendly folks of all types are also welcome to attend (please wear garb) and share your love of the SCA and interest in the middle ages. And for those who already have all the finery a Lord or Lady could desire, perhaps you still wish to add some extra flourishes to the mask you're making for the evening ball?

If you have a project and would like to also have company while you work, we welcome all members of the Barony to an all-day gathering in north Durham. Although no classes are planned at the moment, teachers (or interested students in need of a teacher) are encouraged to speak up to offer or request a class.

We are meeting at the Common House at Eno Commons (overflow participants also welcome at the home of Margaret Wolseley and Giovan Donato). The building you are seeking, the large one with a bank of mailboxes out front, is around the curve to your left, beside the traffic circle. You may park anywhere, although visitors are encouraged to park on the far side of the traffic circle or parallel park along the road.


Directions to get to the

Tears of a Traveler

The morning after Ymir in 1986, a group of friends and I were sitting around a table at the Waffle House in Atillium, talking about an idea we'd hatched up: we wanted to form a Romany Gypsy household! Among those Windmasters present at that first meeting were Lord Calgaich MacPhee, Mistress Hillary Fairehaven, Lady Ceridwen ferch Owain, C. J. Nash (I can't remember her SCA name at the time, but she mostly went by her Gypsy name of Pasquelle Vitae after that day anyway), Ravyn Blackstorm and I. A few months later, at that year's Assessment Battle, the household of Covo Rom held a Gypsy wedding for Ravyn and me, followed by Ravyn being officially made Sher-ingro (tribal leader). Later that year, we formed a rather colorful procession into court, complete with tambourines and banners, to formally ask permission of Their Majesties for our tribe to travel freely within the borders of Atlantia; this was accomplished with our Sher-ingro speaking the petition completely in the Romany language, while I interpreted his words to Their Majesties. After that, there were Gypsy camps at most Baronial (and quite a few Kingdom) events. Our household worked hard to become a source of information about the Romany in Medieval Europe, performing at events, displaying our crafts at demos, and even teaching a multi-subject class in a "Gypsy camp" set up outside on the lawn during an University held at NCSU. And always, there was the music, for the soul of the Gypsy is in the song. Tears of the Traveler was written for the Barony that had accepted us so readily and embraced this new Society culture.
