Letter from the Exchequer

Greetings from Tréphine la Broderesse, Chancellor for the Exchequer for the great Barony of Windmasters' Hill:



At the March Baronial Meeting there were questions about monies paid and monies collected for our monthly Baronial Meetings locations. I did the math and since April 2013 we have collected \$302.06 with passing the hat during meetings. However to date we have spent \$505.00 to pay for meeting locations (and this subtracts the \$175 that Optimist refunded for double booking earlier this year). So the collections are not keeping up with the expenses for meeting sites. Something to think about!

Money! Money! I wanted to report some *good news!* The Bake Sale at Ymir, organized by Baroness Katarina, collected \$560 and the Silent Auction at Tourney of Friends, organized by Lady Helwynn, yielded \$811! So combined these two efforts added \$1,371 to the Baronial coffers, which was slightly more that the profits from Ymir! Thank you to everyone who contributed, purchased, and enjoyed these sales!

Finally, I am working on the first quarter financial report. I will bring a few copies at the May meeting and Althing!

Remember that I am stepping down in August when my warrant expires! Really – I am not kidding!

Competitions:

MAY Flowers! - Any time period, any medium, as long as it includes flowers. Any type of flower! Minimum documentation (Time period, location, and materials used) required, but more in-depth documentation encouraged of course!

Mother May I - This competition is for the kids. Something you think your medieval mom needs, whether it's braided cords to tie up your little brother, or a posey to keep the plague away! Two different age categories - one prize for the 12 and unders, and one prize for the 13 and ups! Minimum documentation encouraged, but not required.

Casa Bellini's C&I Challenge - Scribes of all levels! Beginning, Intermediate, Advanced - Any time period and location, BUT - Calligraphy and Illumination must be documented from the same manuscript. No mixing and matching! Materials are wide open, but points will be awarded for more historically appropriate materials. Minimal documentation is required, preferably including a picture of your source, and any analysis you did in recreating the piece. Pieces must be a Baronial Award blank - Kittyhawks, Boreas, Eurus, Notus, St. Nicolas, Don Quixote, etc. Baronial awards can be found here - http://windmastershill.org/awards/ All entries become the property of the Baron and Baroness of Windmasters' Hill after the competition. Fantastic Scribal prizes!

Relics and Reliquaries—There will be two categories - religious and non-religious. Religious reliquaries and their holy contents were known throughout the Middle Ages. Use an existing saint or create one of your own, and create a relic and a reliquary for it. Tell us who your saint is, what relic is nestled within the reliquary, and what its holy power is. This competition will be judged by judges. Documentation (at least EZDoc) is required. The second competition is for the buskers, bawdy entertainers, charlatans, and snake oil salesmen among you. Come up with your best entertainment or medicinal remedy and hawk it to the crowds throughout the day. There will be cards with your name and product at the A&S area and the populace will vote by casting "coins" into your "purses." Be creative, energetic, and entertaining. This is for the spirit of the day and the joy of the sheep ...er ... populace so WOW them with your cure for the pox or alternative to leeches! No documentation is required.

WINDMASTERS' HILL COOKS GUILD

Adventures with Tostee

I know Tostee is a funny name. But it is a simple recipe you can make at home in less than 20 minutes. You can find a good redaction by Daniel Myers at (http://medievalcookery.com/recipes/tostee.html)

The following are things I have noticed when preparing the sauce. While toast is what is called for in the original I have been using crackers, apples and shortbread cookies in the place of toast. The sauce is pretty sweet so whatever you put it on really does not need to be that sweet.

The basic redaction starts with ¼ cup of red wine and ¼ cup of clarified honey. I start by heating the pan on low medium heat. Then adding the wine and honey. Start stirring the mixture. I use a spatula since

there is only a small amount liquid. The honey will start thick, but as it heats up the mixture will start to act more and more like water. You may also notice the honey not mixing with the wine till it warms up. I try to make sure that while bubbling that the mixture does not go into a full boil.

The mixture will start to "thicken". The easiest way to notice that is drag your spatula through the mixture and see how long the trailing tail lasts. This should start to happen pretty quickly. The liquid should pour easily while hot, but it will thicken as it cools. Spices can be added if you want but I have found the sauce enjoyable without adding many spices.
