Letter from the Chronicler

Greetings from your Chronicler!



As always, I am looking for submissions for the Windlore. Remember we have some demos coming up which might be some great photo opportunities (but remember to get those releases)!

And speaking of Release Forms....

There have been a few questions recently regarding the Model Release form for photographs so here is what the Society Chronicler Policy has to say regarding the matter:

"In addition to the issue of getting the photographer's permission to use a photograph on a website, there is the question of ability to use a person's image, as in a group photograph or large scene. This concern's an individual's right to privacy, and the right to control use of one's image. Unlike public figures, private persons have a very strong right to control their image. Just because they are in a public or semi-public place, be it a park or a rented hall, a person in the SCA is a private person and those rights must be honoured. Just because someone is standing at the front of the room, or sitting on the dais under a crown or coronet, does not turn them into a public person.

Therefore, before using any person's image on a website (or in a printed publication), you must have the permission of that person. It should be in writing, just as permission to publish a poem or drawing or article would be. The key is whether the person can be easily identified. If the only way to identify the person is by the surcote worn over armor, or knowing that a certain lady wears a pink dress with a blue veil which is seen on the back of a woman in the corner of a photo, you probably do not need to worry. But if you can see their face, or other identifying characteristics – the "can their grandmother recognize them in this picture?" determination – or if you want to use their name and identify all persons in the photo, then you should obtain permission."

Also, please make sure that if you are an officer or a canton seneschal that you review your information in the Windlore each month to make sure I have it up to date. I try to watch the lists and webpages but I might miss something.

The Metropolitan Museum of Art – Public Domain Digital Images

The Metropolitan Museum of Art announced in May that more than 400,000 high-resolution digital images of public domain works in their collection can now be downloaded from the museums website for non-commercial use.

This program called the Open Access for Scholarly Content (OASC)—provides access to images of art in its collection that the Museum believes to be in the public domain and free of other known restrictions. Images available for

free, non-commercial use are designated with this icon . Not all images on the museum website are available for free use because of copyright or other issues so please make sure that any images you download for use contain the OASC designation.

Please remember that the Materials are made available for limited non-commercial, educational, and personal use only, or for fair use as defined in the United States copyright laws and users must cite the author and source of the materials and the citation should include "The Metropolitan Museum of Art, followed by the specific information identified as the "Credit Line" on the Collection page for each work of art. The citation must also include the URL www.metmuseum.org".

An example of citation in MLA style format would be

Artist's last name, first name. Title of artwork. Year. Name of institution/private collection housing artwork. Title of database or website. Publisher/sponsor of database or website. Medium consulted. Date of access. <URL>.


