Baronial Officers—Minister of the Lists (MOL)



The Ministers of the List (MoLs) work in partnership with the Marshals administering the combat activities within Atlantia. The MoLs are responsible for all the paperwork necessary to maintain fighters' authorizations and run combat scenarios at events. It is a warranted position run through the kingdom office.

Summarized Job Description for Baronial MoL:

- 1. Maintain current membership and warrant as an MoL.
- 2. Keep a current list of warranted MoLs in the barony.
- 3. Remind those whose warrants are about to expire to renew and provide them with upcoming opportunities to take a refresher session of the MoL 101 class.
- 4. Encourage those interested to come and sit a table, see how it works, and then take the moL 101 class and begin the warranting process.
- 5. Be available to MoL at canton and baronial events or to staff a table with MoLs from within the barony and beyond its borders if we have need.

Deputies:

Any warranted MoL could take over this position at any time and has all the necessary information to maintain the position as long as the prior MoL maintained up-to-date-records. There is not a need for a deputy as it is simply a record-keeping position.

MoL duties described in the Atlantia Book of Policy: http://law.atlantia.sca.org/Policy.html#4

NOTE: This refers only to the Kingdom MoL and MoLs who participate in events. The baronial MoL is not a required position and is not governed specifically by policy or required to send in monthly or quarterly reports based on the office. It is a strictly supervisory/administrative position.

- 4.2 Becoming a Minister of the Lists
 - 4.2.1 MoLs shall be warranted for a period of two years. Warrants shall be issued and maintained at the discretion of the KMoL.
 - 4.2.1.1 All MoL's must request warrant renewal from the KMoL in writing. MoL's must work a minimum of 1 event in the previous year in order to remain warranted; this requirement may be waived at the KMoL's discretion.
 - 4.2.2 Anyone wishing to become an MoL must attend the MoL 101 class and complete the MoL internship program.
 - 4.2.2.1 After taking the MoL 101 class, the MoL trainees must complete a written test. Upon completion of the written test and internship program:
 - 4.2.2.1.1 The Intern must submit, in writing, their desire to take on the office, legal name, SCA name, address, phone number, home branch, email (if available), membership number, and membership expiration date. To support the KMoL office's electronic publication efforts, the candidate must also indicate whether they want quarterly packets in print (receive hardcopy packet) or electronic form (download from the Worldwide Web). The trainee must also confirm or deny 'permission to publish' their contact information in print and/or on-line.
 - 4.2.2.2 The internship program consists of the following:
 - 4.2.2.2.1 The Deputy KMoL for Training maintains a list of senior MoLs who are qualified to act as Mentors. Interns must assist a Mentor MoL at a minimum of two events.
 - 4.2.2.2.2 Both events must involve a tournament format or list tree so the Intern may gain field experience in running tournaments.
 - 4.2.2.2.3 In order to train at an event, the Intern MoL must get prior approval of the MoL-in-Charge of the event.
 - 4.2.2.2.4 After each event is complete, the Mentor MoL mentor who worked with the Intern at that event will sign off on the Intern's paperwork. The Intern does not have to work with the same Mentor for both events, although they may.
 - 4.2.2.2.5 After the Intern completes two events, they must submit the completed Internship forms with their Mentors' signatures to the Deputy KMoL for Training, who will review the Intern's paperwork, discuss their progress with the Mentoring MoLs, and either recommend warranting or further training.
 - 4.2.2.4 The Deputy KMoL for Training may, at their discretion, waive the Internship requirements.
 - 4.2.2.5 Intern may not serve as a group officer nor as a MoL-in-Charge. They may not sign off as MoL on any list office paperwork. A Mentor warranted MoL must supervise all of an Intern's activities.



Baronial Officers—Minister of the Lists (Continued)



4.3 Duties of a Minister of the Lists

- 4.3.1 A warranted MoL is required to administer all combat activities at Atlantian events. For the purposes of this policy only, an Atlantian event is defined as any event announced in The Acorn. Any combat activity, including tournaments, demos, war practices, and training at Universities or Collegiums, held at these events requires an MoL.
 - 4.3.1.1 Each event shall have an MoL-in-Charge who is responsible for filing a tournament report within 14 calendar days of the event.
- 4.3.2 The MoL must ensure that each fighter checks in and completes the appropriate paperwork prior to entering the lists.
- 4.3.3 The MoL shall prepare one report for each tournament held at an event. If you have three tournaments, the KMoL's office should receive three report forms.
 - 4.3.3.1 If a tournament is scheduled but does not occur or is started but not completed, the MoL should send a tournament report stating this fact and the reason, for example bad weather or lack of marshals.
 - 4.3.3.2 All fees collected must be included with the tournament report. If fees are not paid the authorization or renewals will be void. These funds may not be run through personal accounts. MoLs must have a branch Exchequer issue a check for the total amount. Checks must be made out to "SCA, Inc./ Kingdom of Atlantia" and be included with the tournament report.
 - 4.3.3.3 A copy of the tournament report shall be submitted to the seneschal of the sponsoring branch.
- 4.3.4 Each month the KMoL will publish a list in The Acorn of overdue tournament reports. The MoL-in-Charge will have one month from the date of notification to submit the tournament report or contact the KMoL to resolve any problems.
 - 4.3.4.1 If at the end of the first month of past due notification, the MoL-in-Charge has not resolved the problem with the KMoL, the branch Seneschal will be responsible for locating and submitting the missing report or rectifying any issues with that report. The branch seneschal will have a second month to submit the missing report. The MoL-in-Charge will be suspended.
 - 4.3.4.2 At the end of two months, if the KMoL has not received the communication concerning the missing report, the branch sponsoring the event will be suspended from holding martial activities at events. All authorizations and/or renewals processed at the event may be voided by the KMoL. An announcement will be placed in The Acorn concerning the status of the authorizations/renewals.
 - 4.3.4.2.1 This suspension of the branch will be permanent unless all issues can be resolved and a letter is received from the branch seneschal requesting that the branch be reinstated. The suspension of the MoL-in-Charge will be permanent unless all issues can be resolved with the KMoL.
 - 4.3.4.2.2 Branches that have been suspended will be barred from holding fighting events until they have resolved all issues surrounding the event or the KmoL has approved a substitute for a specific tournament/event. Branch suspensions will be published in The Acorn.
- 4.3.5 It is recommended that all independent branches (such as Shires, Baronies, and Strongholds) and sub-branches (Cantons and Colleges) have an MOL if they wish to host fighting events.



Baronial Officers—Minister of Arts & Sciences (MoAS)



Summarized Job Description for Baronial MOAS:

- 1. Write a report for the Kingdom MOAS describing the A&S activities at each Baronial event (classes, workshops, competitions, displays, people involved, etc.)
- 2. Write a quarterly report for the Kingdom MOAS documenting every Baronial level class, demo, workshop, published article, or other A&S oriented activity occurring within the quarter.
- 3. Be available to the members of the Barony for assisting them in finding resources (people or information) to practice and learn about the arts and sciences of SCA period.
- 4. Other supplementary tasks the MOAS could do to promote A&S include:
 - a) Organize classes, workshops, competitions, bardic circles, and other teaching activities at Baronial meetings, events, etc.
 - b) Assist Canton MOAS officers in promoting their activities and networking throughout the Barony
 - c) Keep track of who is proficient in which arts in the Barony
 - d) Organize Baronial efforts to present art projects at other events like Pennsic, Kingdom A&S Festival, Universities. etc.
 - e) Write articles for the Baronial newsletter about what Baronial members are working on in the arts.
 - f) Encourage Baronial members to participate in the annual Baronial Static and Performing Arts Champion competitions.
- 5. Possible MOAS Deputy Tasks:
 - a) Assist in gathering data regarding A&S activities at events and throughout the barony
 - b) Write down who did what at an event and pass that on to the MOAS
 - c) Assist in keeping track of who is proficient in which arts in the barony
 - d) Encourage baronial members to enter their data into the online A&S Directory Spreadsheet
 - e) Focus efforts on a particular kind of art: performing, scribal arts, garb making, etc.
 - f) Make special effort to work with a focused group of artists to organize classes, workshops, articles, etc. and write reports for the MOAS to include in the quarterly report.

Baronial Web Page Summary:

The Ministry of Arts and Sciences seeks to provide resources for members of the Society for Creative Anachronism who are interested in the arts and sciences of the Middle Ages and Renaissance, and to promote the work of local Society artisans and craftspeople.

MOAS duties described in the Atlantia Book of Law: http://law.atlantia.sca.org/Policy.html#7

- 7.2.1.3 Arts and Sciences officers must make themselves available to their local memberships. To this end, they must have a phone and should make their phone number generally available to the group.
 - 7.2.2 Primary duties of local officer are as follows:
 - 7.2.2.1 To ensure that event reports are filed for each local event.
 - 7.2.2.2 To encourage the Arts and Sciences in the local group. This may be approached in any of a number of ways including, but not limited to, sponsoring classes, competitions, and displays at events, encouraging members of the populace to exchange knowledge and skills through workshops, classes, or published articles, and bringing promising and gifted members to the attention of the Crown or Baronage (if applicable).
 - 7.2.2.3 To train deputies in the practices of the local office in order to serve the populace and ensure a reasonably smooth change of office.
 - 7.2.2.4 To maintain accurate and complete files, providing institutional memory.

7.3 Reports

- 7.3.1 All officers must submit, in writing, event reports to the Kingdom officer. In groups without an Arts and Sciences officer, the Seneschal is responsible for filing reports (see Atlantian Great Book of Law, Policies of the Great Officer's of State, Seneschal's office, section 1.3.3.1).
- 7.3.2 Officers of local groups within a greater Barony must report directly to the Kingdom officer, sending a copy to their Baronial officer. All officers must send a copy to their local Seneschal. Baronial officers are encouraged to work with the local officers of groups within their Barony coming to a mutually amicable agreement to meet reporting deadlines. In case of a subsidiary group without an Arts and Sciences officer, Baronial group officers are encouraged, but not required, to provide reports on the subsidiary group's activities. (Seneschals of subsidiary groups are not required to report if the Arts and Sciences office is vacant.)

7.3.3 Event Reports

7.3.3.1 An event report must be filed by the local Minister of Arts and Sciences within two weeks of each event and must include the following:

- Name and contact information of the local Minister of Arts and Sciences and anyone who assisted with the A&S activities of the day.
- Type of activities held; classes, competition, exhibition (display), and categories of the above.
- Judges and Entrants Roster.
- Winner of Competitions and any honorable mentions, if applicable.
- Any comments about the activities, judging, or entrants.
- Recommendations may be made here.
- Any problems that occurred during or after the event and resolutions for them.

University of Atlantia

The 88th Session of the University of Atlantia will be hosted on September 20th in Apex, NC hosted by Canton of Elvegast. This will be a unique experience as an outdoor University and will allow for non traditional classes to be taught that are not usually allowed in a school venue.

Kingdom Arts & Sciences (KASF) Persona Pentathlon & Triathlon

March 7, 2015

The Atlantian Order of the Laurel would like to invite any and all to enter their annual Persona Pentathlon and Persona Triathlon to be held at Kingdom Arts and Science Festival on March 7, 2015.

What is the Persona Pentathlon and the Persona Triathlon?

Persona Pentathlon is a competition where each entrant submits five items that a single persona would have owned or used. Your entry does NOT have to be YOUR persona. But the five items need to be for one persona. There are seven categories and 3 of your five items must be from 3 different categories. The categories include suggested entries, but are not limited to such.

Persona Triathlon is for youth (17 and under) entrants who must have three different items that relate to a single persona.

Category 1: bookbinding, calligraphy, drawing, illumination, painting, papermaking, pigments & inks, sculpture

Category 2: beadwork, clothing accessories (including belts, pouches, and fans), clothing/costume (600-1100, 1101-1350, 1351-1450, 1451-1600, or non-European), hats, knitting, nålbinding, knotted work, lacemaking, needlework (counted thread or free form)

Category 3: ceramics, enameling, glass blowing, lampworking, lapidary, mosaic, pottery, stained glass

Category 4: basket weaving, brewing & vintning, cooking, dyeing, furniture making, herb craft, soap making, spinning, toys & games, weaving (full-sized fabrics or narrow bands)

Category 5: lyric composition, masks, music composition, performance (vocal, instrumental, poetry, story-telling), poetry, prose, dance performance and composition, martial arts performance, research paper

Category 6: armor, chain mail, blacksmithing, jewelry smithing, iron work, tool making, casting, leather work, wood carving and construction, making musical instruments

Category 7: heraldic display, horse barding, subtleties, and anything else that just doesn't seem to fit into the other categories

Please Note: Each item must have separate documentation. ALL ADULT ENTRIES WILL BE JUDGED US-ING THE NEW KINGDOM CRITERIA JUDGING FORMS EXCEPT for the youth triathlon, which will use the youth triathlon form. If you wish to enter a RESEARCH PAPER as one of your category entries, you MUST contact Mistress Jessamyn di Piemonte no later than MARCH 1, 2015 so that she can arrange to have your paper read BEFORE KASF. RESEARCH PAPERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS ENTRIES ON THE DAY OF KASF. Contact Mistress Jessamyn at gmorrismusic@gmail.com if you have any concerns or to consult about the categories your entries might fall under so that they meet the entry requirements.


