# Meeting Notes from the 17 Aug 2014 Barony of Windmasters' Hill Monthly Business Meeting

Meeting Called to order: 5:00 PM

Paid Members in Attendance: 25

Non-Paid Members in Attendance: 2

Seneschals Comments:

Asked if we had any newcomers in attendance: there were 3, they were welcomed

Proposed event budget for Ymir, \$7,560 – the \$500 deposit already paid. Motion made and seconded. Discussion held, motion passed 20 for 0 against.

Details of Discussion, Adelric will be the Autocrat. We will not use a U-Haul, Adelric will use his truck and trailer. The Baronage will take care of Prizes for the event. Event attendance costs will increase to Site \$12, Feast \$10 and Cabin \$18.

Polling of Confidence being conducted. 12 September is the due date for polling letters. Seneschal will notify populace when letters have been sent out. Currently awaiting mailing labels from Kingdom. Motion made and seconded for \$300 to cover the cost of postage and envelopes. Motion passed 19 for and 0 against.

We have several events coming up in the near future, University sponsored by the Canton of Elvegast; Midnight at the Oasis sponsored by the Canton of Nemenfeld; War of the Wings where we will have a Baronial Camp; and the BBBBBBBBBBB, Canton of Buckston event. Please come on out and support out Canton and Baronial event activities.

War of the Wings Baronial Encampment. You must pre-register for Land by 25 September, which require an ACCEPS registration first. Once you have those, you need to e-mail the Camp Steward your tent info on the Baronial Web Page. The Camp Steward is Adelric Falke. We will be planning for a Baronial Dinner of Friday night. More to follow via e-mail notifications.

The September Business Meeting will be held at the Honeycutt Park in Fuquay-Varina in 21 September.

The date for the October Business Meeting will be determined around the War of the Wings event. And the November Business Meeting will be at the Canton of Buckston Event site.

- Exchequer: Total \$17,116.52; Un-allocated \$16,501.52; Allocated \$615 (\$50 Baronage, \$500 emergency, \$65 fire table); Spent \$960.95 (\$400 Pennsic tent rental, \$560.95 Pennsylvania storage shed fee's). Current Annual reoccurring expenses \$2,062.95. Pennsic flyer advertised a VISA credit card through UMB Financial Corp featuring your own personal SCA Name and Device on it.
- Herald: Working on silk banners classes for War of the Wings
- Quartermaster: Will inquire with Optimist Farm if we can leave baronial stuff needed for Midnight at the Oasis at the site from the University event at the same site a week prior.
- A&S: Preparing a possible bid for a 2<sup>nd</sup> Baronial Event in the spring
- Chatelane: Keep a lookout for newcomers

Canton Seneschal Reports:

- Attillum: The Autism Demo planned for 6 September is cancelled
- Buckston: Plan on attending the B to the tenth power event in November
- Elvegast: Plan on attending University in September. Cut off for classes is Wednesday 20 August.
