

Message from Alain de la Rochelle (adding to the Atlantian Friendship Challenge)

Baronial Officers-Chatelain

Greetings Windmasters,

I'm here to help the newcomers.

The Office of Chatelain for local branches reports to the Kingdom Chatelain. It is a warranted office with 2 year terms that can be extended in 2 year increments without limit. The requirements to obtain a warrant are as follows: a prospective Chatelain must be recommended for the office by their local branch. They must attend a Chatelain 101 class. They must submit a warrant request to the Kingdom Chatelain. And they must be a card carrying member. Further, warranted Chatelaines must join the e-list, to keep up with announcements and such from Kingdom. There are Quarterly reports that must be submitted. The Atlantian Book of Policy covers a few more details. Chatelaines are expected to be familiar with Atlantian Law and Policy.

The office of branch Chatelain is an example of the proverbial 'beast with two masters'. While they report to the Kingdom Chatelain, the office operates as assistant to the Seneschal. I can assure you that the duties to Kingdom are small indeed, and that the office of Kingdom Chatelain is very much a resource and is there to help and encourage branch officers as much or more than anything else.

The function of the office as assistant to the Seneschal, in service to the Barony, is where the greater portion of the duties are. As Baronial Chatelain, I help with demos, respond to inquiries through the Windmasters' Hill web page, set up classes for newcomers, maintain a small library of publications and fliers to show and distribute at events, and assist Canton Chatelaines.

Really, the office is a bunch of fun. This is my first office in the Society. Lord Adelric and our Excellencies are a joy to work for and have been very kind and patient in trying not to load me with too much to do and overwhelm me. Experienced Chatelaines have stepped up and helped me greatly. Canton Chatelaines are doing their own thing. Members of the populace are creating and running demos. I am just hoping to grow in this office to be of more help to you all.

Here's a bit more from Kingdom Policy. Quoting this time:

"...assist in newcomer recruitment, education, and acclimatization, and retention. Chatelaines are expected to assist the Seneschal regarding the media, promotional demonstrations (demos), and educational programs for new members...act as the newcomer liaison for a branch and ensure that all information that goes out to the public conveys a true, accurate, and unbiased sense of the purpose and intent of the SCA....encourage people who show an interest to join the SCA and become involved in their local group. Furthermore, to help those new members, through education, to more easily assimilate into the SCA and their local branch."

A lot of what is in that quote is covered in what is written above it.

There are two points that I want to draw out. Firstly, regarding media, meetings and fighter practices should be in the community calendar and what's up pages of local media... [not events]. Just to let those in our communities without SCAdian friends know that we exist. The Society is nearing its 50th year and no one's ever heard of us. It could help. I could use help making that happen. On the other hand, old media might be dead. So I want to encourage everyone to share their activities and positive experiences with family and friends... co-workers, clients and congregations; always being mindful of how the Society is portrayed.

Secondly, there is retention and acclimation. I want to help people transferring into our area, that are already in the Society, to find their place in our groups and feel welcome.

Lastly, are there ideas, or issues that I, as Chatelaine, might be able help you, patient reader, with? Please let me know.

Proposed Corpora Language Change

The SCA Board of Directors seeks commentary on a proposed Corpora language change recommended by the Laurel Sovereign at Arms.

Current language for Corpora VIII.B.2

2. Kingdoms may establish awards and orders conferring Awards or Grants of Arms, and the Crown may award membership in such orders according to the laws and customs of the kingdom. The names and insignia of these awards and orders must be ratified by the Laurel Sovereign of Arms. The order of precedence among orders conferring Awards or Grants of Arms shall be established according to the laws and customs of the kingdoms. Principalities may establish their own awards and orders, but the approval of the Crown is required before these awards and orders may convey Arms.

Proposed language for Corpora VIII.B.2

2. Kingdoms may establish awards and orders conferring Awards or Grants of Arms, and the Crown may award membership in such orders according to the laws and customs of the kingdom. The names and armory of these awards and orders must be registered by the Laurel Sovereign of Arms. The order of precedence among orders conferring Awards or Grants of Arms shall be established according to the laws and customs of the kingdoms. Principalities may establish their own awards and orders, but the approval of the Crown is required before these awards and orders may convey Arms.


