Proposed language for Corpora VIII.B.4

Non-armigerous awards and orders may be established by a kingdom, principality or barony, according to the laws and customs of the kingdom. The names and armory of these awards and orders must be registered by the Laurel Sovereign of Arms.

Baronial Officers—Seneschal

To us, the SCA is the coolest hobby on the face of the earth; but in the eyes of the U.S. Government, the SCA is a non-profit business. And like a business of any kind you have business functions like meetings, reports and other necessary mundane activities. The Seneschal, it the primary business representative for a Barony or Canton and is responsible to oversee those business activities.

In a Canton the Seneschal is also the leader to the group. In a Barony, the dynamic is a little different as it also has the baronage, who although are not legal representatives, are the leadership of the group. So in a Barony the Seneschal and Baronage are a type of partnership in keeping a Barony running smoothly.

The term of office for a Seneschal is generally two years; however in Windmasters' Hill, we like to time a Seneschals term that is does not end at the same time as the Baronage for the sake of continuity.

The primary duties and responsibilities of the Seneschal for the Barony of Windmasters' Hill are:

Hold the monthly Baronial Business Meetings (A minimum of 8 meeting per year required by SCA and Kingdom Law). This includes arranging meeting locations, sending out notices and reminders about the meeting.

Ensuring that the Barony hold events to raise funds necessary to cover operating expenses.

Conducting Polling's of Confidence and for new Baronage as required.

Submitting Quarterly Seneschal Reports. Ensuring all Baronial Officers Submit Quarterly Reports

Keep Baronial Officer positions filled by recruiting replacements as necessary and support the Baronial Officers in their duties.

Constantly coordinate with the Baronage

Perhaps your most important duty or responsibility is to be of service to the will of the Barony.

The Kingdom Chatelain Office has two immediate openings: Northern Regional Deputy and Southern Regional Deputy. If you are an experienced Chatelain, with good communication and interpersonal skills, and would like to learn more about how the office operates I would love to hear from you.

As per section 10.4 of the Kingdom Chatelain Policy (<http://law.atlantia.sca.org/Policy.html#10.4>), the duties of a Regional Deputy are as follows:

- ⇒ Be familiar with The SCA Organizational Handbook and the Laws and Policies of Atlantia.
- ⇒ Assist in training the branch Chatelains.
- ⇒ Be available to assist branch Chatelains with problem solving within their group.
- ⇒ Receive and read the quarterly reports of the local groups in your area.
- ⇒ Hold at least twice annual meetings in their region for local Chatelains at a large event in your region.
- ⇒ Communicate at least quarterly with the local Chatelains.

Additional responsibilities to include assisting with gathering quarterly reports and supporting an online Chatelain presence. The Northern Regional Deputy and Southern Regional Deputy Chatelain positions are both “Officers of State” per Kingdom Law (please see Kingdom Law Sections 4.5 and 5.4 for additional responsibilities and/or restrictions associated with the office). If selected, the initial term of office is three (3) years.

The Atlantian Order of the Laurel would like to invite any and all to enter their annual Persona Pentathlon and Persona Triathlon to be held at Kingdom Arts and Science Festival on March 7, 2015.

What is the Persona Pentathlon and the Persona Triathlon?

Persona Pentathlon is a competition where each entrant submits five items that a single persona would have owned or used. Your entry does NOT have to be YOUR persona. But the five items need to be for one persona. There are seven categories and 3 of your five items must be from 3 different categories. The categories include suggested entries, but are not limited to such.

Persona Triathlon is for youth (17 and under) entrants who must have three different items that relate to a single persona.

Category 1: bookbinding, calligraphy, drawing, illumination, painting, papermaking, pigments & inks, sculpture

Category 2: beadwork, clothing accessories (including belts, pouches, and fans), clothing/costume (600-1100, 1101-1350, 1351-1450, 1451-1600, or non-European), hats, knitting, nalbinding, knotted work, lace-making, needlework (counted thread or free form)

Category 3: ceramics, enameling, glass blowing, lampworking, lapidary, mosaic, pottery, stained glass

Category 4: basket weaving, brewing & vintning, cooking, dyeing, furniture making, herb craft, soap making, spinning, toys & games, weaving (full-sized fabrics or narrow bands)

Category 5: lyric composition, masks, music composition, performance (vocal, instrumental, poetry, storytelling), poetry, prose, dance performance and composition, martial arts performance, research paper

Category 6: armor, chain mail, blacksmithing, jewelry smithing, iron work, tool making, casting, leather work, wood carving and construction, making musical instruments

Category 7: heraldic display, horse barding, subtleties, and anything else that just doesn't seem to fit into the other categories

Please Note:

- * Each item must have separate documentation.
- * ALL ADULT ENTRIES WILL BE JUDGED USING THE NEW KINGDOM CRITERIA JUDGING FORMS EXCEPT for the youth triathlon, which will use the youth triathlon form
- * If you wish to enter a RESEARCH PAPER as one of your category entries, you MUST contact Mistress Jessamyn di Piemonte no later than FEBRUARY 1, 2015 so that she can arrange to have your paper read BEFORE KASF. RESEARCH PAPERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS ENTRIES ON THE DAY OF KASF.
